**MAPS & DIRECTIONS TO THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL AT JCMC**

### From The North

From I-26 East, take Exit 36 (State of Franklin Rd.) and turn right. Go approximately 3.5 miles. The Children's Hospital at Johnson City Medical Center (JCMC) will be on your left.

### From The South

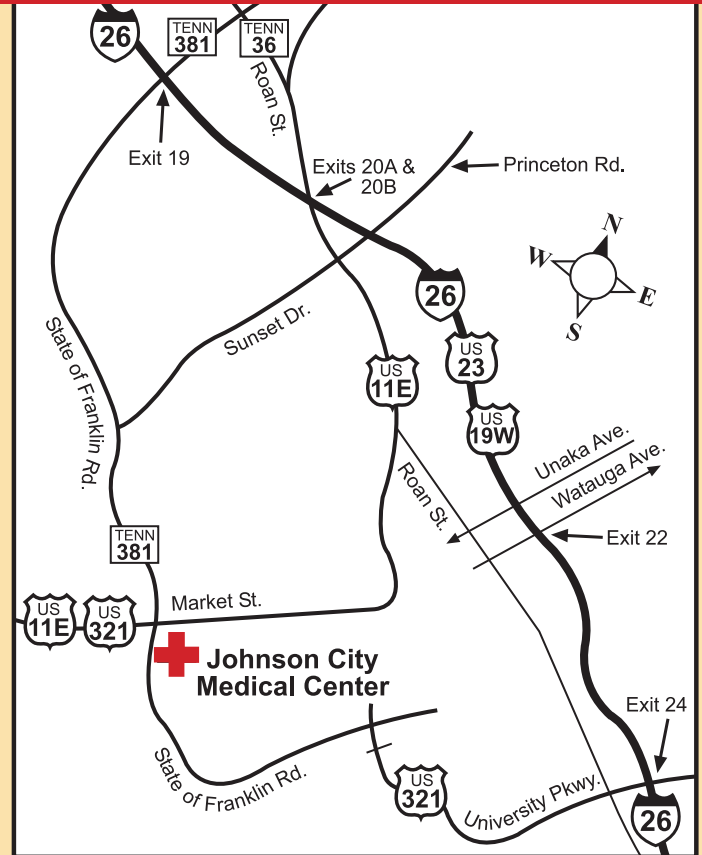
From I-26 West, take Exit 31 (University Parkway/Elizabethton) and turn left. Proceed through 4 traffic lights and at the 5th light, turn left onto State of Franklin Rd. Go approximately 1 mile. The Children's Hospital at JCMC will be on your right.

### From The East

From Elizabethton, take US-321 into Johnson City. US-321 will become University Parkway. From the I-26 interchange, proceed on US-321 to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto State of Franklin Rd. Go approximately 1 mile. The Children's Hospital at JCMC will be on your right.

### From The West

From Greeneville and Jonesborough, take US-11E and US-321 east into Johnson City. These routes will become Market St. Turn right at State of Franklin Rd. (Tennessee route 381). The Children's Hospital at JCMC will be on your left.



### Parking

Parking for patients and visitors is free and is available in front of Johnson City Medical Center (JCMC). Patients may be dropped off at the main entrance, but vehicles may not remain at the front entrance without a driver. The Mountain States Auxiliary offers a courtesy shuttle service to accommodate visitors who need assistance to the hospital entrance. The courtesy shuttles are usually available from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. until 9 p.m. Monday through Friday and additional time on the weekends as volunteer schedules allow. RV and camper spaces are available in the visitor parking lot.

### Registration

The Registration area is located to the right of the main entrance of Johnson City Medical Center. You will need a copy of the physician order, as well as your insurance and payment information. Patient co-payments and deductibles are due at the time of service.
